Giant footsteps to follow

Marching Giants raising funds for new uniforms

In 1969, not only did the Marion High School Marching Giants win the state championship, but it was also considered one of the best

high school marching bands in the world. It was the peak of success for the MHS bands.

In the decades that followed, though, as the population of the city declined and with it enrollment numbers at Marion Community Schools, the marching band dwindled. In fact, for more than a decade, Marion High School had no marching band at all.

But in 2014, that changed. MHS Director of Bands Josh Huff brought the MHS Marching Giants back to life; Marion's is the only competitive marching band in Grant County, and the Marching Giants are proud to represent the city and the

county in competitions around the state.

The high school band program is not the only one growing. In fact, there are more than 100 students enrolled in 6th-grade band, and about 300 enrolled in our junior high band program.

With such a strong program at the lower levels, the high school band is looking forward to continued growth. Marion Community Schools is proud to provide these opportunities to young musicians.

However, with growth comes more costs. Among the needs are new marching band uniforms (sample seen at left!). The ones currently in use are 15 years old, and not only are they showing wear and tear, but there are too few to accomodate the continued growth of the band.



34th annual MHS-Florida reunion

Seventy-five Marionites gathered for a reunion at Duff's Original Buffet restaurant in Bradenton, Fla., on Thursday, March 1, 2018.

Marion The first High School-Florida Reunion was held at Stacey's Buffet in Largo, Florida on March 1, 1984. It was organized by Charlie Kilgore (retired Marion Postmaster) and Laverne Bradford (the first MHS Easter Queen - 1934). It was promoted, for many years, by Bill Fowler of WBAT who was widely known for many years as the "Voice of the Giants."

The event was moved to Duff's in Bradenton in March 2011, when the Largo buffet was closed. The annual event has always been held on the first Thursday in March.

The emcee this year was Jerry Shull (MHS class 1962). Carmen Lindsay Ramsey led the enthusiastic group in singing the chorus of Back Home Again in Indiana, The Marion High School Fight Song and God Bless America.

The group took a break for a great buffet lunch that offered a large variety of country style cooking plus Mexican and Italian dishes. One could finish their meal with a choice of many scrumptious desserts.

Dr. Pierre J. Fisher, retiring president and member of the MHS Class of 1949, opened the afternoon plenary session with a few welcoming and historical remarks.
