

Congratulations to the 2015-16 MHS boys basketball team, who earned a hard-fought state title on March 26, the eighth in Giants history!

This ties Marion High School with Muncie Central High School for the most boys basketball state titles.

The team was led by four seniors (soon to be MHS

alumni): Vijay Blackmon, Reggie Jones, Jordan Smith, and Juswon White.

The team overcame a tough Evansville Bosse team, ultimately winning 73-68. (Bosse is coached by MHS alum and former basketball assistant coach Shane Burkhart.)

The Giants came from behind in the fourth quarter five times

in the tournament, including in the state championship game. This team's hard work, perseverence, poise, and heart have inspired the school and the community. And they've proved once again that GIANTS FIGHT, NEVER DIE!


